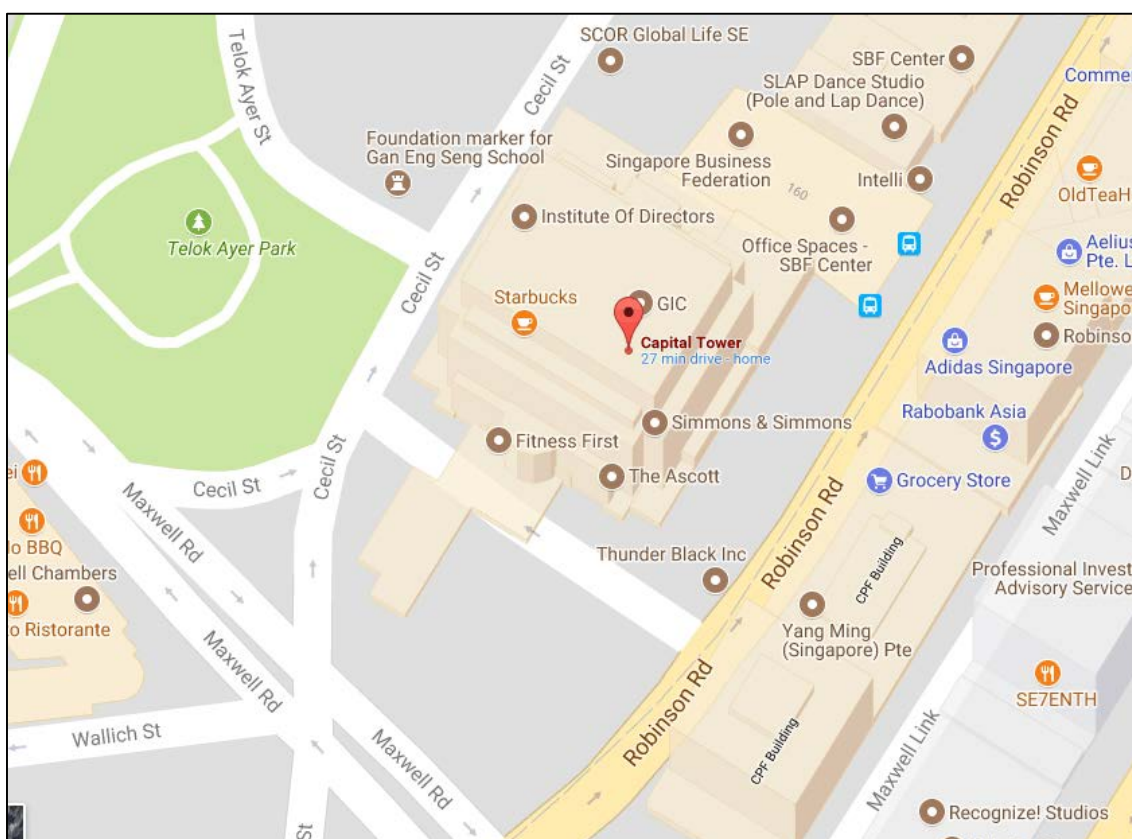


# Nautical Forum 9/18
