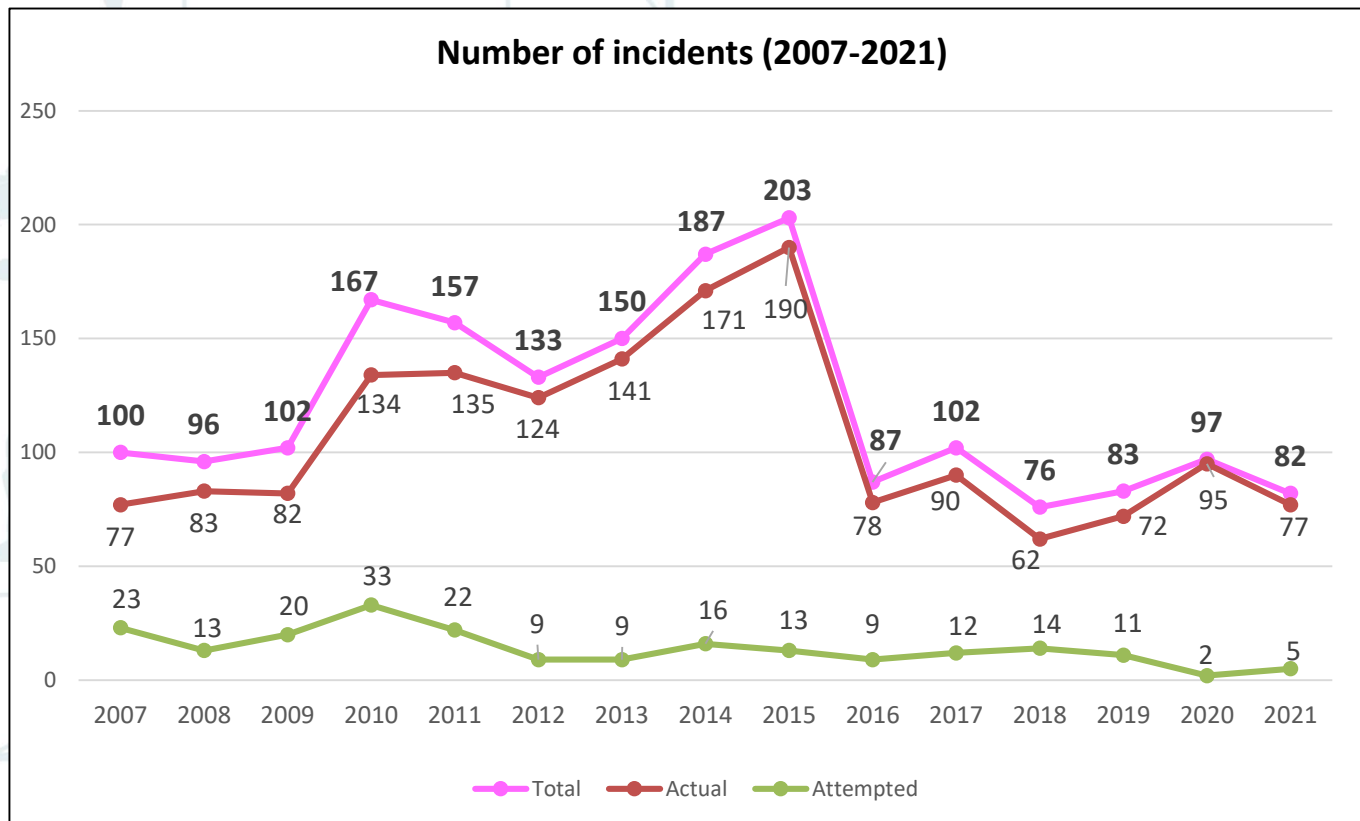


Situation Update (2021)

Number of Incidents

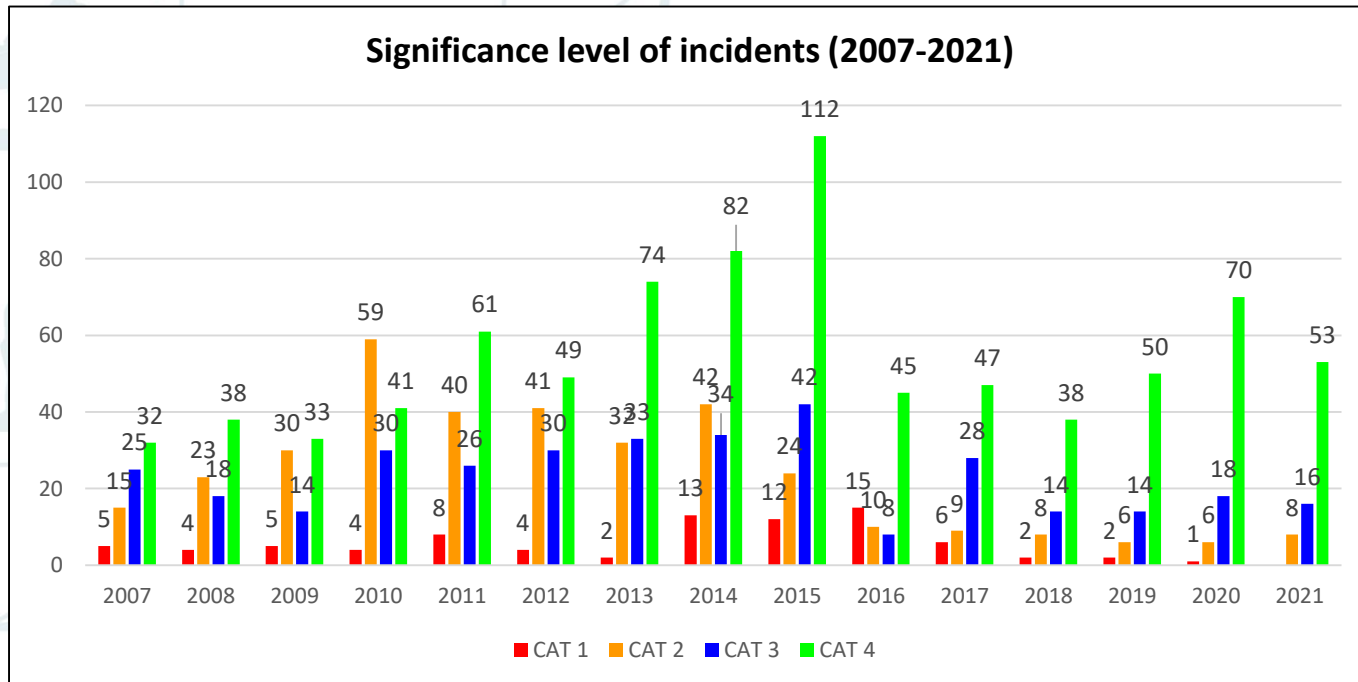
- ❑ **82 incidents** (77 actual and 5 attempted) **in 2021**
- ❑ Total incidents: **decrease by 15%** compared to 2020 (97 incidents)
- ❑ Actual incidents: **decrease by 19%** compared to 2020 (95 incidents)
- ❑ **2nd lowest** in total incidents in the last 15 years (2007-2021)



Situation Update (2021)

Severity of Incidents

- ☐ **77 actual incidents in 2021**
 - **CAT 2: 10%**, **CAT 3: 21%**, **CAT 4: 69%**
no **CAT 1** incident: 1st time in the last 15 years
 - Increase of **CAT 2** compared to previous 2 years (2019, 2020)
crew threatened with guns/knives, held hostage temporarily
 - Slight decrease of **CAT 3** compared to 2020
 - Majority are **CAT 4** incidents (perpetrators not armed, crew not harmed)

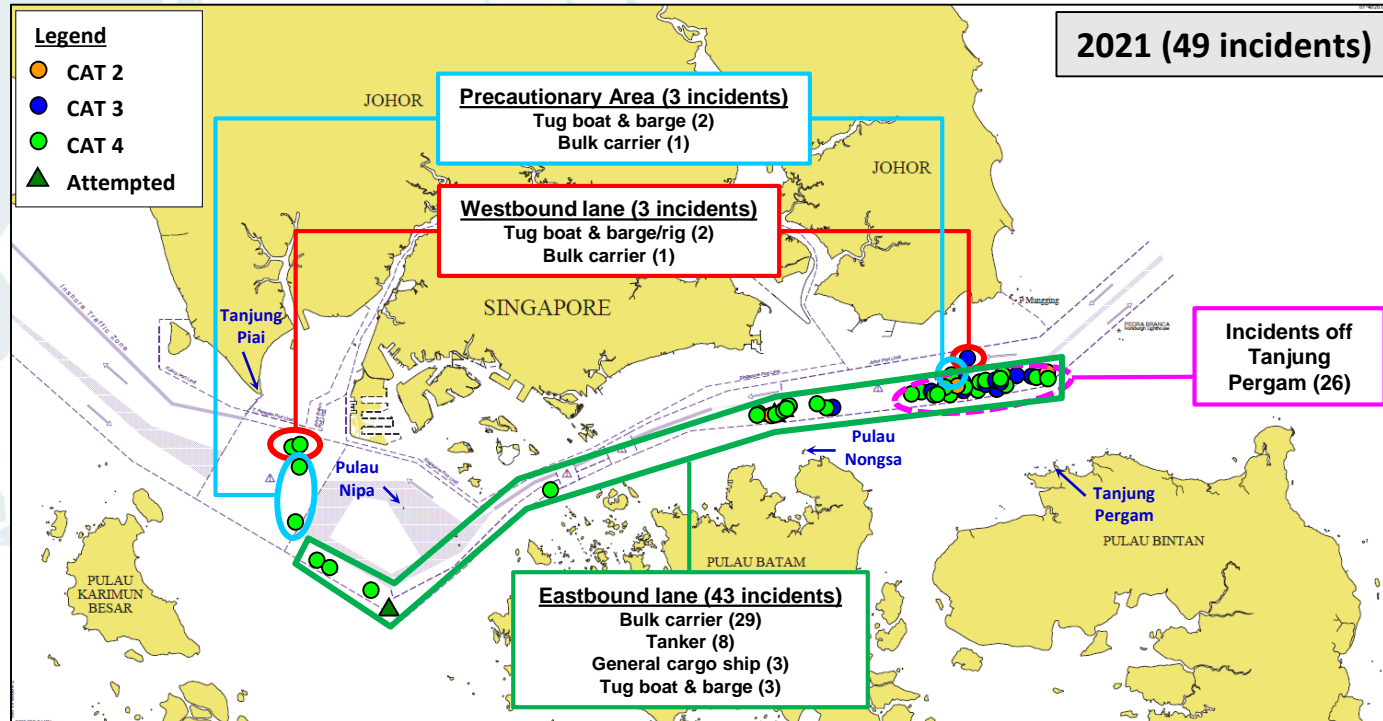

Situation Update (2021)

Situation in Singapore Strait



- ❑ **43 incidents** in eastbound lane of the Traffic Separation Scheme (TSS)
 - 3 x **CAT 2**, 10 x **CAT 3**, 27 x **CAT 4**, 3 x **Attempted**
 - **26 incidents** occurred off Tanjung Pergam, Bintan Island, Indonesia
 - **12 incidents** occurred off Nongsa, Batam Island, Indonesia
- ❑ **3 incidents** in westbound lane of the TSS (1 x **CAT 3**, 2 x **CAT 4**)
- ❑ **3 incidents** in precautionary area of the TSS (3 x **CAT 4**)

Abduction of Crew in Sulu-Celebes Seas



Situation Update

- No incident was reported since January 2020
- No crew is currently held in captivity
- However, the Threat of abduction of crew remains high

As the leaders of the kidnapping group (Abu Sayyaf Group) responsible for the abduction of crew incidents are still at large
