<p>Details of Incident :</p> <p>The tanker while at anchor was approached by one small boat with eight men who attempted boarding from the stern of the ship.</p> <p>The master of the ship raised the alarm and the small boat fled away. The crew conducted a search of the ship and found no damages or items stolen.</p>

Comments by ISC :	The last time an armed robbery incident occurred in the vicinity was approximately a month ago on 27 April 2007 when four robbers armed with knives boarded a ship to steal some engine spares. Ship masters operating in the vicinity are advised to maintain vigilance at all times.
